

#### **MASS INTENTIONS**

Mass intentions are a good way to remember and pray for your loved ones, alive or deceased. If you would like to request an intention please remember to submit your intentions for Liturgy ASAP by calling the parish office at 864.469.9119 or by email at <a href="mailto:bill@saintrafka.org">bill@saintrafka.org</a>. Please remember that it is rare to be able to have your intention the following Sunday! Masses are now generally booked up about three months in advance.

#### **BAPTISM & CHRISMATION**

Baptism in the Maronite Rite is always accompanied by *Chrismation* (Confirmation). Both Sacraments are given by a priest, and always in the same ceremony. Preparation to receive the Sacraments of Baptism and Chrismation is required. We encourage this to happen before the birth of your child. Please contact the <a href="Church Office">Church Office</a> for more details.

#### ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The Anointing of the Sick is routinely offered during the Divine Liturgy on Wednesday evening and during pastoral visits by the priest to homebound and ill parishioners. Let me know if you will be in the hospital or have other special needs. Contact the Church Office.

#### THE MYSTERY OF CROWNING (MARRIAGE)

Couples must contact the pastor **at least** six months prior to the desired date of the wedding. To initiate the marriage preparation process or if you have questions for weddings taking place at Saint Rafka. Contact the **Church Office**.

#### **PARISH REGISTRATION**

Registration forms and welcome packets are available in the church office and the vestibule. Membership is a condition for the reception of the sacraments of baptism/confirmation, first reconciliation, first Eucharist, and Crowning (marriage). Registration is also required before the parish can issue a sponsorship certificate for those asked to be sacramental sponsors. You must be a registered, contributing member for at least three months before a certificate is provided.

# **Scripture Readings**

Isaiah 40:6-11

A voice says, "Proclaim!" I answer, "What shall I proclaim?" "All flesh is grass, and all their loyalty like the flower of the field. The grass withers, the flower wilts, when the breath of the LORD blows upon it." "Yes, the people is grass! The grass withers, the flower wilts, but the word of our God stands forever." Go up onto a high mountain, Zion, herald of good news! Cry out at the top of your voice, Jerusalem, herald of good news! Cry out, do not fear! Say to the cities of Judah: Here is your God! Here comes with power the Lord GOD, who rules by his strong arm; Here is his reward with him, his recompense before him. Like a shepherd he feeds his flock; in his arms he gathers the lambs, Carrying them in his bosom, leading the ewes with care.

2 Cor. 10:1-11

Now I myself, Paul, urge you through the gentleness and clemency of Christ, I who am humble when face to face with you, but brave toward you when absent, I beg you that, when present, I may not have to be brave with that confidence with which I intend to act boldly against some who consider us as acting according to the flesh. For, although we are in the flesh, we do not battle according to the flesh, for the weapons of our battle are not of flesh but are enormously powerful, capable of destroying fortresses. We destroy arguments and every pretension raising itself against the knowledge of God, and take every thought captive in obedience to Christ, and we are ready to punish

every disobedience, once your obedience is complete. Look at what confronts you. Whoever is confident of belonging to Christ should consider that as he belongs to Christ, so do we. And even if I should boast a little too much of our authority, which the Lord gave for building you up and not for tearing you down, I shall not be put to shame. May I not seem as one frightening you through letters. For someone will say, "His letters are severe and forceful, but his bodily presence is weak, and his speech contemptible." Such a person must understand that what we are in word through letters when absent, that we also are in action when present.

John 1:29-34

he next day he saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God,\* who takes away the sin of the world. He is the one of whom I said, 'A man is coming after me who ranks ahead of me because he existed before me.' I did not know him,-but the reason why I came baptizing with water was that he might be made known to Israel." John testified further, saying, "I saw the Spirit come down like a dove-from the sky and remain upon him. I did not know him,-but the one who sent me to baptize with water told me, 'On whomever you see the Spirit come down and remain, he is the one who will baptize with the holy Spirit." Now I have seen and testified that he is the Son of God."

#### Reflection

In the Gospel of John of Epiphany (of divine manifestations), Jesus reveals himself to us as Light to the world, as well as the Light for life in it's fullness. Furtheron in the passage Jesus reveals his unique relationship to the Heavenly Father. This is a divine relationship of son-ship with the Father. Being one *with* the Father, he can speak *for* the Father, by using the divine expression: *I AM!* 

Saint Paul, in his address to the Christians of Corinth, reminds them how through faith they have been given the grace to see Christ as he is — in the light of his divinity — while other people see him only partially — as Moses saw God with a veiled face.

In our Syriac Spirituality we find St. Ephrem speaking in mystical poetry of the light of Christ residing in every Christian: the same light that Moses saw on the mountain at the burning bush; that gleamed through Mary at his incarnation, and the river Jordan at his baptism. Ephrem envisions that we too will shine forth with Christ's light at our resurrection – for all eternity!

It is very important for us to come to know Jesus Christ, our Lord, in his true light: as he really lives in the light of the Trinity. It is the ultimate grace from God the Father to have Jesus revealed to us in his true Light. This grace can only be given to those who are willing to seek it: "ask and it will be given to you," the Lord says.

As the Lord is transfigured before us, so we also, come to be revealed to ourselves and to each other as Children of God – and the Children of the Light.

Our Church proclaims with joy to Christ at the *Sedro* on the Sundays of Epiphany:

You have clothed us with your baptism:

the robe of glory and the seal of the holy Spirit.

You have called us to be spiritual children

through our second birth in baptism..

May the *Light* of Christ, the Risen Lord, continue to be the *Light* of our lives every day;

May it never leave any corners of darkness in us untouched;

May the forgiveness and healing his *Light* brings fully transform us;

That we too, the children of the Church, may truly become the *Light* of Christ for the world, as we pray before the altar at the end of our Eucharistic Celebration.




