MASS INTENTIONS

Mass intentions are a good way to remember and pray for your loved ones, alive or deceased. If you would like to request an intention please remember to submit your intentions for Liturgy ASAP by calling the parish office at 864.469.9119 or by email at <u>secretary@saintrafka.org</u>. Please remember that it is rare to be able to have your intention the following Sunday! Masses are now generally booked up about three months in advance.

BAPTISM & CHRISMATION

Baptism in the Maronite Rite is always accompanied by Chrismation (Confirmation). Both Sacraments are given by a priest, and always in the same ceremony. Preparation to receive the Sacraments of Baptism and Chrismation is required. We encourage this to happen before the birth of your child. Please contact the <u>Church Office</u> for more details.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The Anointing of the Sick is routinely offered during the Divine Liturgy on Wednesday evening and during pastoral visits by the priest to homebound and ill parishioners. Let me know if you will be in the hospital or have other special needs. Contact the <u>Church Office</u>.

THE MYSTERY OF CROWNING (MARRIAGE)

Couples must contact the pastor **at least** six months prior to the desired date of the wedding. To initiate the marriage preparation process or if you have questions for weddings taking place at Saint Rafka. Contact the <u>Church Office</u>.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Registration forms and welcome packets are available in the church office and the vestibule. Membership is a condition for the reception of the sacraments of baptism/confirmation, first reconciliation, first Eucharist, and Crowning (marriage). Registration is also required before the parish can issue a sponsorship certificate for those asked to be sacramental sponsors. You must be a registered, contributing member for at least three months before a certificate is provided.

Scripture Readings

2 Samuel 7:8-17

Now then, speak thus to my servant David, Thus says the LORD of hosts: I took you from the pasture, from following the flock, to become ruler over my people Israel. I was with you wherever you went, and I cut down all your enemies before you. And I will make your name like that of the greatest on earth. I will assign a place for my people Israel and I will plant them in it to dwell there; they will never again be disturbed, nor shall the wicked ever again oppress them, as they did at the beginning, and from the day when I appointed judges over my people Israel. I will give you rest from all your enemies. Moreover, the LORD also declares to you that the LORD will make a house for you: when your days have been completed and you rest with your ancestors, I will raise up your offspring after you, sprung from your loins, and I will establish his kingdom. He it is who shall build a house for my name, and I will establish his royal throne forever. I will be a father to him, and he shall be a son to me. If he does wrong, I will reprove him with a human rod and with human punishments; but I will not withdraw my favor from him as I withdrew from Saul who was before you. Your house and your kingdom are firm forever before me; your throne shall be firmly established forever. In accordance with all these words and this whole vision Nathan spoke to David.

Gal. 3:15-22

Brothers, in human terms I say that no one can annul or amend even a human will once ratified. Now the promises were made to Abraham and to his descendant. It does not say, "And to descendants," as referring to many, but as referring to one, "And to your descendant," who is Christ. This is what I mean: the law, which came four hundred and thirty years afterward, does not annul a covenant previously ratified by God, so as to cancel the promise. For if the inheritance comes from the law, it is no longer from a promise; but God bestowed it on Abraham through a promise. Why, then, the law? It was added for transgressions, until the descendant came to whom the promise had been made; it was promulgated by angels at the hand of a mediator. Now there is no mediator when only one party is involved, and God is one. Is the law then opposed to the promises [of God]? Of course not! For if a law had been given that could bring life, then righteousness would in reality come from the law. But scripture confined all things under the power of sin, that through faith in Jesus Christ the promise might be given to those who believe.

Luke 1:26-38

n the sixth month, the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a town of Galilee called Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man named Joseph, of the house of David, and the virgin's name was Mary. And coming to her, he said, "Hail, favored one! The Lord is with you." But she was greatly troubled at what was said and pondered what sort of greeting this might be. Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name him Jesus. He will be great and will be called Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give him the throne of David his father, and he will rule over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end." But Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I have no relations with a man?" And the angel said to her in reply, "The holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore the child to be born will be called holy, the Son of God. And behold, Elizabeth, your relative, has also conceived a son in her old age, and this is the sixth month for her who was called barren; for nothing will be impossible for God." Mary said, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." Then the angel departed from her.





Reflection

On this Sunday "the Church rejoices with Mary..," and her children sing glory for that heavenly announcement Mary has received and accepted on our behalf (*Opening Prayer*).

Today, the Letter of Saint Paul to the Galatians, reminds us of how the promise made to Abraham is now being fulfilled through those who believe; those who live by the Law and the Torah of the heart through righteousness. To such as these – like Mary – is the *gift* of God and his *promise* handed down through his angels. The Gospel of Luke makes it clear that Mary is this righteous one who has gained the favor of God, and thus, inherited this *Gift* (Christ) and the *Promise* (Salvation).

In the Gospel-Icon of Mary and the Angel drawn for us by Saint Luke, and framed for us in this Sunday's prayers – in the context of the relationship of the Creator with his creation – the mountains, the earth, the sea, and the waves are *rejoicing in God's Word*! Mary herself has become *the New Earth* (As Saint Ephrem would teach us) and true representative for all of God's creation. The Son of God comes to dwell in her, and through her God has returned to live – as in *Paradise* – in the midst of his creation. Now in Mary, the new covenant, and God's plan of salvation is being fulfilled. She has become the *Cloud*, the *Pure Womb*, the *Fountain of Life and Blessings*!

As we re-visit these Gospel passages through the meditation-prayers of the *Hoosoyo* we contemplate how benevolent God has been to our

human nature! How Mary has fulfilled the hope that God had invested in humanity. In the dialogue-meditation of Mary with the Angel we see a reflection not only of Mary herself, but also of our humanity, in dialogue with divinity. First, Mary responds with fear and amazement to the divine angel showing her human vulnerability – and also our mortality before God's divinity – but as she answers the angel of God we also find in her courage, true faith, and wisdom.

Saint Ephrem, the great poet and teacher of our Syriac tradition, speaks of Mary as the *New Eve*, and yet also the new *Garden of Eden* and *Paradise*: God's dwelling in our human world. In the midst of this new *Garden of Paradise* now stands Christ – the *Tree of Life* in the *New Paradise* – who gives *Life* to all who receive him from the hands of Mary. Mary's acceptance – her *fiat* – has made us children of God. Now she is both the mother of Christ – and as our representative – our mother as well!

Like Mary, the Church and her children, have become dwelling places for God, from where God's loving care for humanity reaches out to the world. Now God has come to dwell among us – Emanuel (God with us). The good news of the Gospel that Mary has received from the angel – is the good news we now have to share with all of humanity through justice and peace. Like Mary, we too, the Church and her children, are called to become both receivers and heralds of God's great tidings of hope for humanity.

"Thank you, O Mother, for your acceptance!"






