#### **MASS INTENTIONS**

Mass intentions are a good way to remember and pray for your loved ones, alive or deceased. If you would like to request an intention please remember to submit your intentions for Liturgy ASAP by calling the parish office at 864.469.9119 or by email at <u>secretary@saintrafka.org</u>. Please remember that it is rare to be able to have your intention the following Sunday! Masses are now generally booked up about three months in advance.

### **BAPTISM & CHRISMATION**

Baptism in the Maronite Rite is always accompanied by Chrismation (Confirmation). Both Sacraments are given by a priest, and always in the same ceremony. Preparation to receive the Sacraments of Baptism and Chrismation is required. We encourage this to happen before the birth of your child. Please contact the <u>Church Office</u> for more details.

#### **ANOINTING OF THE SICK**

The Anointing of the Sick is routinely offered during the Divine Liturgy on Wednesday evening and during pastoral visits by the priest to homebound and ill parishioners. Let me know if you will be in the hospital or have other special needs. Contact the <u>Church Office</u>.

### THE MYSTERY OF CROWNING (MARRIAGE)

Couples must contact the pastor **at least** six months prior to the desired date of the wedding. To initiate the marriage preparation process or if you have questions for weddings taking place at Saint Rafka. Contact the <u>Church Office</u>.

### PARISH REGISTRATION

Registration forms and welcome packets are available in the church office and the vestibule. Membership is a condition for the reception of the sacraments of baptism/confirmation, first reconciliation, first Eucharist, and Crowning (marriage). Registration is also required before the parish can issue a sponsorship certificate for those asked to be sacramental sponsors. You must be a registered, contributing member for at least three months before a certificate is provided.

## **Scripture Readings**

Luke 8:16-21

#### Ezekiel 44: 1-5

When you apportion the land into inheritances, you shall set apart a sacred tract of land for the LORD, twenty-five thousand cubits long and twenty thousand wide; its whole area shall be sacred. Of this land a square plot, five hundred by five hundred cubits, surrounded by a free space of fifty cubits, shall be assigned to the sanctuary. Also from this sector measure off a strip, twenty-five thousand cubits long and ten thousand wide, within which shall be the sanctuary, the holy of holies. This shall be the sacred part of the land belonging to the priests, the ministers of the sanctuary, who draw near to minister to the LORD; it shall be a place for their homes and pasture land for their cattle. Also there shall be a strip twenty-five thousand cubits long and ten thousand wide as property for the Levites, the ministers of the temple, that they may have cities to live in.

II Corinthians 4:1-6

Therefore, since it is by God's mercy that we are engaged in this ministry, we do not lose heart. We have renounced the shameful things that one hides; we refuse to practice cunning or to falsify God's word; but by the open statement of the truth we commend ourselves to the conscience of everyone in the sight of God. And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing. In their case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God. For we do not proclaim ourselves; we proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord and ourselves as your slaves for Jesus' sake. For it is the God who said, 'Let light shine out of darkness', who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

o one after lighting a lamp hides it under a jar, or puts it under a bed, but puts it on a lampstand, so that those who enter may see the light. For nothing is hidden that will not be disclosed, nor is anything secret that will not become known and come to light. Then pay attention to how you listen; for to those who have, more will be given; and from those who do not have, even what they seem to have will be taken away.' Then his mother and his brothers came to him, but they could not reach him because of the crowd. And he was told, 'Your mother and your brothers are standing outside, wanting to see you.' But he said to them, 'My mother and my brothers are those who hear the word of God and do it.'



# Reflection

Today is the Feast of the Nativity of the Mother of God. We do not normally commemorate the births of saints, but John the Baptist and Mary, the Mother of God, are two exceptions because, like Christmas, the Birth of Christ, they impact our salvation. Mary's Nativity in particular is second only to Christmas, when our Lord and God was born as a man, come to mankind to save us from sin. His Mother's birth, then, is important because it allows His birth – her birth is the beginning of the fulfillment of what had been promised to the prophets for thousands of year.

Mary's birth is a sign of Christ, the Hope of All, because it fulfills the ancient promises He made to His people awaiting His coming since the Fall of Adam. With Mary's birth, three hopeful promises are fulfilled, which our tradition emphasizes in their hymns. The first is that "the Lord will not forsake His people" (Ps. 94:14). The People of God are those who love Him and follow His commands. Joachim and Anna, the parents of Mary, are two steadfast examples of God-loving people. They were known for being righteous, and for praying and fasting constantly. But for sixty vears they were childless – and as such, for sixty years they were considered cursed by God by their contemporaries and prohibited from offering sacrifice in the Temple. But they did not despair, though other humans claimed their hard times were a curse from God. They continued their lives in love of God and God did not forsake them, remaining true to His word. But instead blessed them with the daughter who is blessed by all generations as the holiest of women to bear the Son of God.

As our Lord promises His disciples, He turns sorrow into joy for those who follow Him (John 16:20). From the very beginning of the prophets and patriarchs, God promised both fruitfulness and great nations while Abraham and Sarah were barren. Rachel was barren for Jacob, and the High Priest Samuel's wife could not conceive. But when least expected, God granted them the promise given to them. This theme is repeated thoroughout the prayers of the Nativity of Mary because she is the descendant and fulfillment of all the patriarchs. The Syriac prayers emphasize the transmission of this great blessing, the Hope of the Hopeless, Who is Christ, until it reaches Mary. The most terrible barrenness that has plagued the world since Adam is sin, which stole life from us. With the birth of Mary, the vessel for Life Eternal is prepared.

The greatest and most ancient promise which Mary's birth fulfills is the promise our tradition says Christ made to Adam. Reflected in Ezekiel (33:11), we believe our Lord is grieved by sin, which brought death into the world and decayed His image in Adam. From the Fall of Adam, Christ began to prepare the way for Him to heal the barrenness of sin. That is why He blessed the prophets repeatedly to foreshadow and transmit His blessing that He will never abandon His people or the sinner, but instead make the barren fruitful and the dead living if they follow Him. Christ became incarnate after the holiest woman ever was born who would become His Mother, Mary. Mary, though Virgin, is the Mother of the Creator of All, Who died to bring us life, in this great paradox.

The Nativity of Mary is a reminder that strife is not a curse from God, but an opportunity for Him to bless us. Moreover, He will not abandon us in our need. That is why we so fondly call Christ throughout our prayers the Hope of the Hopeless. May the prayers of the Mother of God be a rampart to us!

# **Building Committee Update**

Dear Parishioners.

As many of you know, St. Rafka Church has for some time been barely able to accommodate our growing number of parishioners considering our modest church size and inadequate parking on site. So we have been having ongoing discussions at the church about how to best expand our church buildings to accommodate the anticipated increase in attendees.

Ideally we would like to acquire about a 5 acre parcel in the Greer area to build on. Our discussions with builders has concluded that our much beloved St. Rafka site is inadequate to accommodate a new church building on the current site and the many more parking spaces that would be needed. We could only build on our current site if some additional acreage became available for parking. However, we haven't ruled out purchasing an existing church or other buildings if they are suitable to our needs.

Unfortunately, available vacant land in the Greer area has not been located which could be purchased. The large tracts of land directly across from St. Rafka would be perfect for our use but are not currently available. For the time being, our current church building is serving us well if a bit tight, and Francis House and Wickett Hall can continue to serve our needs for some time to come.

So that is a summary of where things currently stand. We will continue to keep our eyes open for a suitable site. We are currently enlisting the help of a competent real estate company to help us in our search. In any case, we see a new St. Rafka site as a multi year project to get where we want to be considering a level of financing that we can manage.
